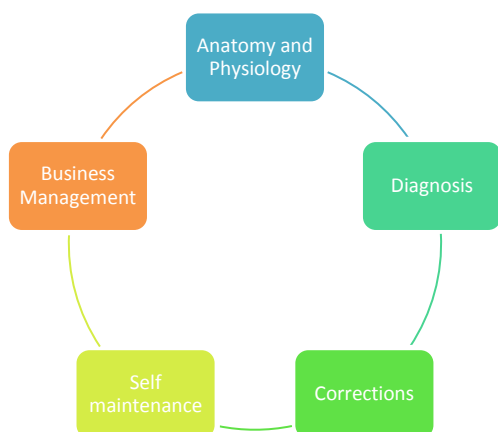
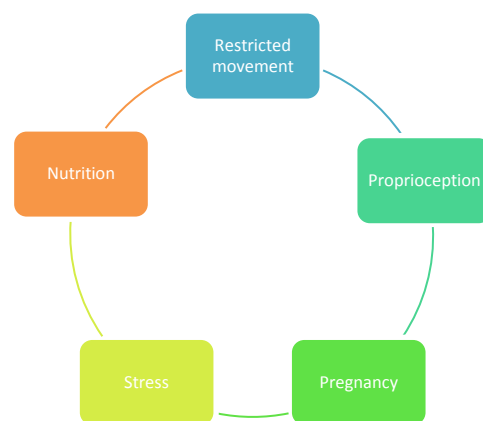


AMATSU KIHON WEEK 6th to 10th December 2010
